Foil balloons can be customised with messages or logos and are less likely to pop, making them durable for indoor and outdoor events. They can be reused if deflated and reinflated properly, offering a more sustainable option. However, they should be disposed of responsibly, as they are not biodegradable. These are long lasting arches that work great indoors or out. Foil balloons create a dynamic, brilliant metallic shine that will surely command the attention of your guests and can potentially last for many days. (Outside weather permitting, foil balloons can tarnish with wet or damp weather, and also shrink when temperatures drop.)
- 8. Double or Triple Arch: For a grander statement, consider a double or triple arch, which layers multiple arches together, creating a more opulent and dimensional display.
